Bao Anh Nguyen

Artistic Director

Having studied with Martin Gatt, the former principal Bassoonist to the London Symphony Orchestra, Nguyen successfully received the prestigious scholarship, "The Queen Elizabeth the Queen's Mother Full Scholarship with maintenance". He also attained the Concerto winner to perform Mozart's Bassoon Concerto with Royal College of Music Chamber Orchestra. Nguyen has appeared as a soloist and as the bassoon principal to several music festivals in Europe, including Schleswig-Holstein Music Festival Orchestra (Germany), Carinthia Music Festival (Austria), Pablo Casal's Music Festival (France), the British Youth Opera (UK).

Principal Bassoon with the Daejeon Philharmonic Orchestra, South Korea from 2005 to 2010. Whilst there he made appearances via the National Broadcasting network, namely *Stravinsky's Rite of Spring*, *Tchaikovsky's 4th, 5th symphonies*, *Britten's War requiem*, *Messiaen Turangallila symphony*, *Richard Strauss's Symphonic poems*, etc.

He is a founder member of the Happy Bassoon quintet (Seoul) 제 8회 정기연주회 Professional performance ensemble, founded in 2007. Bao Anh Nguyen's earlier career appearances as guest Principal Bassoon include: Shanghai Broadcasting Symphony, Macao Orchestra, Hong Kong City Chamber Orchestra, Malaysian National Symphony, Festival Orchestra (Bangkok), Shenzhen Symphony Orchestra.

Bao Anh is a guest principal Bassoon with various orchestras, namely in Seoul, Hong Kong, Macao, China, Malaysia, Thailand and his homeland, Vietnam. He has also appeared with the Opera Society of Hong Kong as Principal Bassoon consecutively since 2010.

Since 2016 Bao Anh became Artistic Director Saigon Philharmonic Orchestra (Saigon, Vietnam), Current Director of the Hong Kong Bassoon Academy and Bauhinia Musik Haus (Hong Kong).

MUSIC DIRECTOR



Fan Ting

Music Director

Ting Fan is one of the legendary violinists of Hong Kong.

Fan first picked up the violin at age four, quickly passing the audition for China's Central Conservatory of Music by age 11. Rejected for admission due to family political background, Fan swam to Hong Kong just before his 14th birthday in pursuit of his musical dream. There, renowned violinist and Hong Kong Philharmonic Orchestra music director Lim Kek-Tjiang took him under his wing as his protégé. 4 months later, Fan officially joined the HK Phil as Assistant Concertmaster.

At age 18, Fan traveled to the States to study with world-class masters at the Curtis Institute of Music. His teachers included Joshua Brodsky, Ivan Galamian, Felix Galimir, and Arnold Steinhardt. After Curtis, Fan went to the Juilliard School for his graduate studies, where he pursued chamber music, orchestral technique, and conducting. There, Fan practiced orchestral repertoire with celebrated concertmasters Glenn Dicterow, Norman Carol, and Joseph Silverstein. He learned conducting under the tutelage of Jorge Mester and took master classes with the great Maestros Leonard Bernstein, Georg Solti, and Claudio Abbado.

After studying abroad, Fan returned to Hong Kong with renewed passion. After his 37 seasons of playing for the orchestra, his main roles have alternated between Principal Second Violin, Assistant Concertmaster, and Acting Concertmaster. His New Art Quartet and Canzone Trio have made concert tours to Taiwan, Japan, Canada, Chicago, London, Cremona, and New York. As a conductor, Fan founded and acted as the first Music Director of the Metropolitan Youth Orchestra, a now very recognized young people's orchestra in Asia.

Outside of his performing career, Fan has taught violin, orchestral technique, and chamber music at multiple universities: Chinese University of Hong Kong and the Hong Kong Baptist University. Moreover, he is recognized as the founding faculty of the Orchestral Technique Class at the Hong Kong Academy of Performing Arts.

Fan hopes to bring classical music to children of all backgrounds. He has done much philanthropic work and established a non-profit fund to fulfill this dream. In his words, he hopes to "bring the joy of classical musicians to the next generation".
